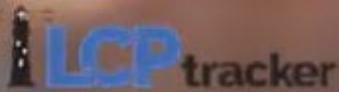

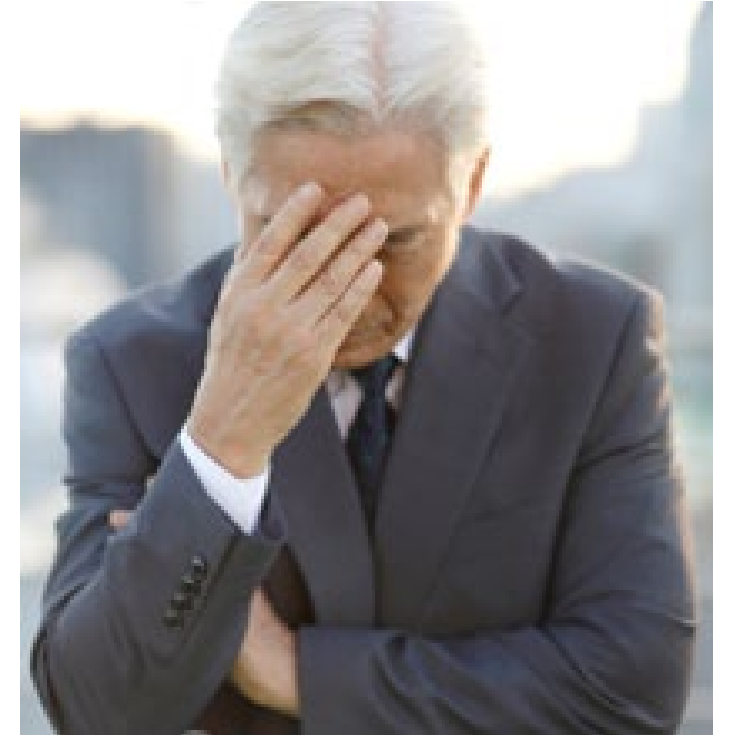

# Typical Labor Interview Process

- Paper form on a clipboard
- Worker signs with pen
- Interviewer takes paper forms back to the office
- Payroll admin compares interview forms with CPR for that week and verifies these items:
  - Employees
  - Hourly rates
  - Project & Contractor Names



# What is OnSite?

- Provides the ability for Compliance Administrators to walk construction sites and perform compliance interviews electronically
- User-friendly, mobile app compatible with tablets on iOS and Android platforms (tablets only)
- Ability to conduct, edit, save and store field interviews electronically online as well as offline (*without internet connectivity*)
- Standard forms like SF-1445 and HUD-11 can be used
- Allows for the capture of hand-written employee and interviewer signatures
- Allows for the capture of up to 5 pictures per interview
